Expression of Interest (EoI) for submission of Project proposals a Captive Employers under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY 2.0) in the State of Chhattisgarh

Chhattisgarh Gramin Aajeevika Samvardhan Samiti (CGSRLM -Bihan) invites Project proposals from registered and eligible Project Implementation Agencies (PIAs) as Captive Employer under DDUGKY 2.0 scheme to allot target of skilling of **5400 candidates (including target of 270 for Person with Disabilities)** for the period of 2026-28.

1. A Captive Employer is any Industry which can

- Provide employment to candidates in their own organization or one of its subsidiaries and have suitable in-house training facilities.
- Having their own requirement to train and absorb the trained persons in their own organizations.
- The Captive employer should be a PIA empanelled with Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India, as per Notification 18/2020 dated 6th October 2020 issued by Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India.

2. Interested and eligible project implementing agencies may submit their proposals as Captive Employer through online at <kaushal.rural.gov.in> along with a non-refundable application fee of Rs. 29,500/- (Including GST) .

3. All the project proposals will go through an initial screening.

5. Qualitative Appraisal is not applicable for Captive Employer Projects

6. The appraisal of DDU-GKY project will be conducted through the IT platform provided by Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India only. Details for filling up online application form are available on the website. <https://kaushal.rural.gov.in>. Applicant project implementing agency should read the guidelines and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) carefully before

filling up the application form. The Guidelines and SOP are available on the website of Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India i.e. <https://kaushal.rural.gov.in>.

7. Proposals should be submitted online on Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India ERP portal **on or before 15th June 2026, 05.00 PM**. Applications received after the scheduled date and time shall not be considered. .
8. The Agency will be empanelled with Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India and CGSRLM under the following category:

1	Priority A	Captive employer	-Maximum Project Target 5000 or 40% of Human Resource of Captive Employer registered with ESIC or PF, whichever is lower -Project period will be of three years -Batch-wise funding

9. In order to be eligible to apply for a project, an entity should be: -

- Minimum 3 years old or should be in existence for past three years
- Valid EPFO/ESIC/Factory registration number
- Valid TIN/ TAN/GST Number
- Valid Bank Account linked with Aadhar/PAN
- Minimum turnover of Rs. 25 Cr per year for last 3 financial years
- Positive Net Worth in at least Two of the last three financial year
- Should have training experience for minimum period of two year
- Should have an existing training centre as per the norms of National Framework Industry specified infrastructure
- Provided employment to 500 or more jobs in own or subsidiary agencies/ companies, during the last three years from the date of application for a project
- Manpower Supplying companies are not eligible. Documentary evidence required for verification.

In case of negative feedback or feedback on poor Performance received from any competent authority with which the agency has worked with in past, it will be liable to be rejected/ terminated at any stage of empanelment process, before or even after empanelment at the discretion of CGSRLM without giving any notice.

10. The following shall not be eligible for applying as PIAs in DDU-GKY:-

- a. Existing PIAs who got DDU-GKY Projects sanctioned and have recovery proceedings going on anywhere in India.
- b. Existing PIAs (PAN India-all States) who were unable to place minimum 50% of trained candidates under DDU-GKY.
- c. Skilling agencies having officials at key managerial personnel as per accounting standard 18, who were earlier associated with defaulting PIAs against whom recovery proceedings were initiated due to default.

- d. Sister concern/subsidiary of any organization against whom default action for recovery of funds initiated.
 - e. Skilling Agencies having Directors involved in agencies that defaulted earlier with DDU-GKY. A provision shall be built into the system for validating the DIN of directors of the applicant organization through Ministry of Corporate Affairs database.
 - f. Skilling Agencies blacklisted by any State Govt. or Govt. of India.
 - g. No consortium is allowed for this EoI.
11. Proposed training duration shall be of 3 to 6 months and fully residential.
 12. For **Persons with Disabilities (PwDs)** with minimum target of 270 reserved under the PwD Category. The PwD Category Guidelines will be applicable as per the Notification no. 43/2017.
 13. All selected Captive PIAs have to commence the training target on or before 31st October, 2026 and must be concluded on or before 31st December 2027 and placement of trained candidates must also begin on or before 31st March 2028.
 14. Agencies (PIAs) are required to strictly follow the DDU-GKY Guidelines, Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), Notifications/Order with respect to the Captive Employer Projects as notified by the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India and CGSRLM from time to time. This includes any updates or modifications to the guidelines and procedures.
 15. CGSRLM reserves the rights regarding
 - Allotment of Targets and Districts.
 - Accept or reject the proposal
 - To award project with modification to the proposal before sanctioning the project
 16. Those who are interested may please apply through the portal <https://kaushal.rural.gov.in> on or before **15th June, 2026**.
 17. The entire process of application of proposal, screening and selection will be done strictly as per the guidelines and norms laid out by Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India.
